### Notes of Discussion

Item No.1 : Confirmation of the minutes of the Sixth Meeting held on 6th November, 1976 :

1. The minutes of the Sixth Meeting held on November 6, 1976, circulated Vide letter, No.SEC/MTG/5376, dated the 17th November, 1976, were confirmed.

Item No.2: Action taken on the minutes of the Sixth Meeting held on 6th November. 1976:

Action by: 2. As the Chairman of the Functional Boards and the tropolitan Junicipal Commissioner were not in a position to attend unicipal the meeting consideration of this item was postponed. It was decided that information relating to the actions to the minutes of the Sixth Meeting should be roan Develop - Committee, for circulating a note in this regard.

Item No.3: Task Force for the preparation of the Perspective Plan and nonitoring of investments - Transport and Communications Board:

3. After a detailed discussion it was agreed that there was a need to set up a Task Force in the Transport and -- Communications Board for preparation and monitoring of a Regional Investment Plan relating to the transport and communications sector. It was felt that the grades specified may not be commensurate with the quality of output expected from the constituents of the Task Force. The Member-Secretary were being made to recruit on Board explained that arrangements semi-Government Organisations staff and officers who may possess the necessary expertise for the work of the Task Force. Depending upon the output of the Task Force once it is in position, the Executive Committee could be approached for higher level posts at the appropriate time. It was agreed that persons having adequate experience in the -- transport planning field should be recruited to the posts.

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It was felt that the designations of the posts should be Planning Officer and Assistant Planning Officers only.

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# Item No.4: Appointments in the posts of Chief Accounts Officer and Secretary to the Financial -Adviser:

4. The Metropolitan Commissioner and the Financial Adviser explained that with the difficulties involved in getting really competent persons for the posts in the Finance and Accounts Division appointment of retired Accounts Officers with extensive experience was the only immediate way to manage the increasing finance and accounts workload of the Authority. They indicated that the present incumbents were quite suitable for undertaking the tasks assigned to them. The Executive Committee agreed to the proposal.

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# Item No.5: Appointment of Staff Officer in the Office of the Authority:

5. The Secretary, Executive Committee, explained that with the increasing workload relating to the meetings of the Authority, Standing Committee, Executive Committee and other special meetings of different Committees required to be arranged by the Metropolitan Commissioner's Office — filling in the already sanctioned post of the Staff Officer had become urgent. The work of this Staff Officer (assisted by one Assistant and a Steno-typist to be shared jointly with the Administrative Staff Officer) would cover the — entire range of matters relating to the meetings including the follow up action on the decisions taken in the meetings. Metropolic The Executive Committee agreed to the proposal.

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## Item No.6 : Appointment of Staff of the B.M.R.D.A. :

6. It was noted that the appointments sought to be approved post facto by the Executive Committee mainly related to -- appointments on deputation powers relating to which are now Acti proposed to be delegated to the various officers of the -- Meta Authority. The proposal put before the Executive Committee Committee approved.

\*7. In regard to the appointment of Technical Assistant to the Member-Secretary, Transport and Communications Board, it was desired that an idea about the actual work output of -- Active officer should be put up before the Executive Committee in the next five to six months.

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# Item No.7: Upgrading the post of Chief Planning Officer, Kalyan Complex:

8. It was noted that the upgradation of the post was being specifically sought for to accommodate the present incumbent in the event of his promotion to a higher grade in his parent Department. The proposal was approved subject to a stipulation that the upgradation was not of the post itself but was to be restricted to the period the present incumbent occupied it.

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# Item No.8: Bombay Metropolitan Region Development Authority. Functions of ----:

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9. As the note on this item was prepared and circulated at the instance of the Chairman, Housing, Urban Renewal and Ecology Board and Weter Resource's Management Board, and as

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both of them could not attend the meeting, it was decided to postpone this item for consideration of the next meeting.

#### 'Item No.9: Delegation of powers for appointing staff and officers of BMRDA:

10. The Member-Secretary, Water Resources Management Board, projected the views of the Chairman, WRM Board, relating to the process of selection of deputationists. It was felt that the Chairmen of the Functional Boards should invariably be associated with the selection. In respect of the appointments to be made by the Financial Adviser and the Secretary, Executive Committee, such consultation should be with the Metropolitan Commissioner.

It was also felt that the delegation of powers should avoid overlapping. For this purpose, the Metropolitan Commissioner's powers relating to making appointments should be for posts the maximum of which exceeds Rs. 1500 per month. Subject to this the proposal was approved by the Executive Committee.

Relating to recruitment to be made from other sources (other than deputations) it was felt that the Committee appointed as per the decision taken in the Sixth Meeting of the Executive Committee held on November 6, 1976 (paragraph 12 of Item No.3) should finalise its recommendations at an on by: early date. Shri B.C.Cariappa, Managing Director, CIDCO., politan should also be associated with the deliberations of this issioner. Committee.

### Item No.10: Bombay Urban Transport Project - technical assistance to the BMRDA for general management, accounting and financial consultancy

13. The Member-Secretary, Water Resources Management Board, projected the views of the Chairman, WRM Board relating to the terms of reference proposed for the consultancy. The Chairman WRM Board, felt that whereas the organisational structure was to be evolved from within, an external consultant for this purpose would not be appropriate. It was generally grazuatly agreed that inducting external expertise in this regard might be of use in evolving a proper organisational structure for the Authority and the Functional Boards. Similar doubts were raised regarding the exact implication of preparation of work programmes for the Functional Boards by the consultants.

14. After a detailed discussion it was decided that the -- detailed terms of reference should be finally evolved by the Metropolitan Commissioner in consultation with the Chairman,
Water Resources Management Board. The ex-Metropolitan Commissioner, Shri K.V.Seshadri, could, if necessary, also be -ion by: associated in these discussions. After agreed terms of ropolitan reference were decided upon in the above manner they could issioner be circulated to the Executive Committee for its consideration.

15. Based on the discussions held in the Seventh Meeting of the Executive Committee of the BMRDA held on December 4, 1976, the following Resolutions were passed :-

RESOLUTION 5:

"Resolved that further to Resolution 4, dated the 6th November, 1976, the Executive Committee, in exercise of the powers under Clauses (ii) and (vii) of Sub-Section (2) of Section 7 of the BMRDA Act, 1974, and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, approve the delegation of its power regarding the appointments of Senior Planner and Junior Planners to the Member-Secret

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of the Housing, Urban Renewal and Ecology Board of the Authority. Resolved further that the appointments be made on the recommendations of the Selection Committee constituted under Resolution 4, dated the 6th November, 1976, of the Executive Committee."

#### RESOLUTION 6:

"Resolved that the Executive Committee do, in exercise of the powers delegated to it by Resolution 38, dated the 17th November, 1976, of the Standing Committee and all other powers enabling it in this behalf approve of the creation of a Task Force under the -- Transport and Communications Board of the BMRDA to compile the Regional Investment Plan and monitor the investments taking place in the Bombay Metropolitan Region in the Transport and Communications Sector.

Resolved further that the Task Force should comprise:

(i) Planning Officer (Rs.650-45-1100-50-1200)

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(ii) Assistant Planning Officers (Rs. 325-25-550-30-800)

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(iii) Steno-typist (Rs.135-5-170-6-200-8-240-10-290) ... 1

Resolved further that the sanction for the above mentioned Task Force shall be current upto 31st March, 1978, subject to adequate budget provision being made available and the Task Force shall be responsible to the Transport and Communications Board through the Member-Secretary."

#### RESOLUTION 7:

"Resolved that, in terms of the powers conferred on, and the duties entrusted to, the Executive Committee as per Section 7(2)(ii) of the BMRDA Act, extension of the terms of appointment of Shri N.S.Bhende, Chief Accounts Officer, for one year from 1-1-1977, and the appointment of Shri N.K.Velayudhan for one year from 1-11-1976 on re-employment basis are approved."

#### RESOLUTION 8:

"Resolved that the Executive Committee, in exercise of its powers under Clause (ii) of Sub-Section (2) of Section 7, of the Bombay Metropolitan -- Region Development Authority Act, 1974, and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, approves the appointment of Shri N.B.Dixit, Superintendent, Public Works and Housing Department of the -- Government of Maharashtra, on deputation to the Authority as the Staff Officer on the standard terms of deputation as may be prescribed by the Government.

Resolved further that Shri N.B.Dixit will work as Staff Officer in the Office of the Metro-politan Commissioner, Bombay Metropolitan Region Development Authority."
