- <u>Item No.1:</u> Confirmation of the Minutes of the last (192nd) Meeting of the Executive <u>Committee held on 25th May, 2001.</u>

Minutes were confirmed.

Item No.2: Action taken on the Minutes of the last (192nd) Meeting of the Executive <u>Committee held on 25th May, 2001.</u>

Action on pending items from the minutes of the meeting from July, 1999 to February, 2001 were circulated during the meeting.

The action taken report was noted by the Committee.

Item No. 3: Placement of additional term deposit of Rs. 240 crs. with Govt. of Maharashtra Finance Department

The Project Director, MUTP, MMRDA submitted that as per the letter received from the Principal Secretary, Finance Department, Government of Maharashtra, an amount of Rs.240 crores was placed with the Government of Maharashtra on 10th July, 2001 after premature withdrawal of deposits from financial institutions on various funds, for which, informal approval was obtained from the Chairman, Executive Committee and Chief Secretary, Govt. of Maharashtra. Further, Project Director intimated that as per Principal Secretary, Finance Deptt.'s letter, Government will refund the said term deposit in 12 equal instalments and pay the similar interest rate on the term deposit, which MMRDA was getting before premature withdrawal of the said deposits.

Shri D.M. Sukthankar, Member of the Executive Committee pointed out that Government had not repaid the earlier term deposits of Rs. 285 crores and outstanding interest thereon of about Rs.157.05 crores upto June, 2001. He further pointed out that in earlier Executive Committee Meetings, it was decided that MMRDA should not lend or place further deposit with organisations who have defaulted in repayment MMRDA's loans/deposits.

The Legal Adviser invited the consideration of the Meeting to the following key questions:

 Whether having regard to the mandate of Article 293 of the Constitution of India, it is permissible to the State Government to borrow the loan as proposed. Whether the term deposit intended to be placed with the State Government, is loan as contemplated in Article 293 of the Constitution.

The Chairman read these Articles and having had detailed discussions with the Members on above issues, it was decided that the Principal Secretary, Finance Department, Government of Maharashtra should be requested to ensure that the provisions of the above articles are complied with.

The Chairman suggested that since the Government of Maharashtra had not repaid the earlier term deposits of Rs.285 crores and interest thereon on time, the MMRDA should ask the Government to give the repayment schedules of the earlier deposits along with the outstanding interest. The present deposits could be placed with Government of Maharashtra for four months instead of keeping it for the period of 12 months as per the request of the Principal Secretary, Finance Department, Govt. of Maharashtra, at the interest rate of 12% along with the other terms and conditions of the deposit.

After detailed discussions, the Committee approved the proposal and passed the following Resolution:-

RESOLUTION NO. 834 :

"RESOLVED THAT the Principal Secretary, Finance Department, Government of Maharashtra be requested to submit repayment schedule for the term deposits of Rs.285 crores along with the outstanding interest of Rs.157.05 crores upto June, 2001 that were placed with the Government of Maharashtra in the year 1995 and 1998 and which are not refunded so far.

"RESOLVED FURTHER THAT the earlier decision taken by the Executive Committee not to renew or place additional

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deposits to the defaulting organisations is hereby relaxed to the above extent in the case of Government of Maharashtra.

"RESOLVED FURTHER THAT the Executive Committee in exercise of its powers under Section 7(3)(v) of the MMRDA Act, 1974 and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, hereby accords its ex-post-facto sanction to the term deposit of Rs.240 crs. to the Government of Maharashtra (Finance Department) for the period of four month at the interest rate of 12% p.a. of standard terms & conditions of the term deposit. The Government of Maharashtra should refund the term deposit along with the interest on due date and if the term deposit is not refunded on due date, 2% penal interest should be charged on the delayed period of the term deposit."

<u>Item No. 4</u>: Award of the work of Feasibility Study of Convention Centre Complex in IFBC, Bandra Kurla Complex.

The proposal contained in the agenda note was discussed in detail and passed the following Resolution: -

RESOLUTION NO. 835:

"RESOLVED THAT in exercise of the powers under clause (iii) of sub-section (3) of Section 7 of the MMRDA Act, 1974, the Executive Committee hereby approves the proposal of awarding the work of feasibility study of Convention Centre Complex in BKC to M/s. Colliers Jardine as per details contained in paragraph 4 of the item note.

"RESOLVED FURTHER THAT in exercise of powers conferred under sub-section (5) of Section 7 of the MMRDA Act, 1974, the Executive Committee authorised the Metropolitan Commissioner to exercise its powers under clause (iii) of sub-section (3) of Section 7 of the MMRDA Act, 1974, and award the work of feasibility study of Convention Centre Complex and also negotiate and execute appropriate agreement with M/s. Colliers Jardine, and to set up a Study Review Committee under his chairmanship with expert members from concerned disciplines if required to review the progress of the study."

<u>Item No. 5</u>: Development of Sports Complex on a vacant Plot admeasuring 12427 sq. mtrs. out of CTS No. 531 of Dharavi Division <u>'H' Block, Bandra Kurla Complex.</u>

The Metropolitan Commissioner submitted that it would be appropriate to first obtain an assurance from, Sports & Youth Welfare Department, Government of Maharashtra that they would take over, operate and maintain the facilities proposed to be developed. He also proposed that public tender will be called instead of inviting offers from short listed Consultants as per enclosed Annexure 'G' to the Item Note.

Then, the Committee accepted the suggestions of Metropolitan Commissioner and approved the proposal contained in the Item Note and passed the following Resolution: -

RESOLUTION NO. 836 :

"RESOLVED THAT in exercise of the powers conferred under clause (ii) of sub-section 3 of Section 7 of MMRDA Act, 1974 the Executive Committee hereby accords its approval to the project of developing sports complex at an estimated cost of Rs.1.5 crores, subject to an assurance being obtained from the Sports & Youth Welfare Department that they will operate and maintain the proposed Sports Complex. **"RESOLVED FURTHER THAT** the Executive Committee authorise the Metropolitan Commissioner to select and appoint a design and project management consultant by inviting open tenders.

"RESOLVED FURTHER THAT the Executive Committee authorises the Metropolitan Commissioner to execute the project."

Item No. 6: Approval to the selection of bidder for procurement of Land and Constructed tenements in lieu of TDR plus cash (Option B) <u>under Mumbai Urban Transport Project.</u>

The Committee discussed the Agenda Note in detailed and decided to deferred Agenda Note.

Item No. 7 : Appointment of Additional Metropolitan Commissioner (Engg.)

After discussion, the Committee approved the proposal contained in the Item Note and passed the following Resolution: -

RESOLUTION NO. 837 :

"RESOLVED THAT the Executive Committee grants the ex-post facto approval to the proposal requesting the Government to appoint Addl. Metropolitan Commissioner (Engg.) under section 11 (1B) of MMRDA Act, 1974 in the pay scale of Rs. 18400-22400 with admissible allowances.

"RESOLVED FURTHER THAT in exercise of the powers conferred on it by clause VII of sub-section 3 of Section 7 of MMRDA Act, 1974 and all other powers on this behalf the Executive Committee hereby approves the delegation to the Addl.

Metropolitan Commissioner (Engg.) which are already given to the Chief Engineer of the MMRDA <u>vide</u> Resolution No. 197, dated 10.4.1981."
